  - analyse the results of tests of parameters and properties of raw materials and textile products,
  - select machinery and equipment for manufacturing textile products,
  - prepare technical and technological documentation of textile products manufacturing and finishing processes,
  - establish parameters of technological processes of textile products manufacturing and finishing,
  - prepare the textile products manufacturing and finishing process,
  - operate machinery and equipment for manufacturing and finishing of textile products,
  - control the conditions and progress of technological processes of textile products manufacturing and finishing,
  - control and correct the progress of the technological process of textile products manufacturing and finishing,
  - use computer programmes supporting the execution of tasks,
- and additionally, within the scope of the professional tasks performed:
- observe the rules of occupational health and safety and apply fire and environmental protection regulations and requirements of ergonomics,
  - provide first aid to the injured in accidents at work and in health and life-threatening situations,
  - apply the provisions of the labour law, legal regulations concerning personal data protection and provisions of tax law and copyrights protection law,
  - use a foreign language and use foreign-language sources of information,
  - organise work of a small team.
