3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The vocational diploma for the occupation of **ship mechanic technician**, for which the qualification **MG.32. Organisation and performance of works connected with the operation of ship machinery, equipment and systems** has been specified, certifies that the holder is able to:

- use technical standards, manuals and documentation and consumables classification documentation in Polish and English,
 - observe procedures for collection to the ship of fuels, lubricants, coolants and industrial gases,
 - distinguish between ships and ship equipment components,
 - distinguish between types of renovation works based on technical specification,
 - perform works related to the disassembly and assembly of ship machinery, equipment and systems,
 - select and apply methods of reconditioning and repair of machine parts,
 - perform works related to the repair and renovation of ship machinery, equipment and systems,
 - perform works for preparing the marine power plant for shipyard repair,
 - activate and operate ship machinery, equipment and systems,
 - perform works related to licenses for basic cutting and welding of components,
 - select control and measurement instruments and equipment for conducting the assessment of the technical condition of ship machinery, equipment and systems,
 - control work parameters of ship machinery, equipment and systems and perform their adjustments under supervision,
 - use specialist computer programmes supporting the performance of tasks,
- and additionally, within the scope of the professional tasks performed:
- observe the procedures of conduct during rescue and emergency actions and ship protection actions to rescue the life of people and property at the sea,
 - observe the procedures of conduct in health and life-threatening situations of ship passengers and crew,
 - observe and apply occupational health and safety, fire control and environmental protection regulations;
 - apply legal provisions relating to the conduct of business activity, labour law and personal data protection law,
 - use a foreign language and use foreign-language sources of information,
 - organise work of a small team.
