Making and repairing eyesight aids have been specified, certifies that the holder is able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">— select and make components to build optical and opto-electronic equipment,— perform workshop measurements of optical and opto-electronic systems and instruments,— perform measurements of geometric and optical parameters of materials,— perform mechanical and optical installation, and tune and align optical and opto-electronic equipment,— repair optical and opto-electronic instruments,— activate and test the operation of optical instruments and devices after installation or repair,— determine refractive errors and the methods of their correction,— perform ophthalmic tests,— match eyesight aids and eye protection measures,— operate devices used in ophthalmic optics and make glasses and other eyesight aids,— adjust and repair glasses and other eyesight aids,— provide advice on the use of eyesight aids,— prepare drawings with the use of computer techniques,— select means and methods of internal transportation and material storage, and additionally, within the scope of the professional tasks performed: <ul style="list-style-type: none">— observe the rules of occupational health and safety, apply fire and environmental protection regulations as well as requirements of ergonomics,— provide first aid to the injured in accidents at work and in health and life-threatening situations,— apply the provisions of the labour law, legal regulations concerning personal data protection, copyrights law and legal provisions concerning business activity,— communicate in a foreign language in the performance of professional tasks as well as use foreign-language sources of information,— organise work of a small team.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate has obtained at least a secondary education and passed examinations for the qualifications specified for the occupation of optician technician: **MG.14. Installation and repair of optical components and systems** and **MG.30. Making and repairing eyesight aids**. These qualifications can be obtained by pursuing one of the following educational paths.
