3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The vocational diploma for the occupation of **watchmaker**, for which the qualification **MG.13. Repair of clocks and watches** has been specified, certifies that the holder is able to:

- identify the structure and classify watches and clocks,
- read from the technical and technological documentation information to perform professional tasks and prepare drafts and drawings of clock and watch components,
- select and use control and measurement tools, equipment and instruments in watch- and clock-making works,
- select materials used in watch- and clock-making works,
- determine the technical condition of watches and clocks and plan on this basis the scope of watch- and clock-making works,
- disassemble, clean, maintain and assemble components and sub-assemblies of clocks and watches,
- time clocks and watches,
- replace and repair damaged components and sub-assemblies of clocks and watches,
- make simple components and sub-assemblies of clockwork,
- evaluate the quality of watch- and clock-works performed and remove any possible defects,

and, in addition, within the scope of professional tasks performed:

- observe occupational health and safety, fire and environmental protection regulations and requirements of ergonomics,
- provide first aid to the injured in accidents at work and in life or health-threatening situations,
- apply the provisions concerning business operation, labour law and personal data protection law,
- use a foreign language and use foreign-language sources of information.
